


Welcome our new Assistant Manager

English Ivy Hedera helix

English ivy is an ever-green climbing vine with dark green lives arranges alternately along the stem. Leaves are three lobed and change to an oval when mature.

English Ivy is an aggressive invader growing densely along the ground and into tree canopies. English Ivy will eventually smother trees causing their death.

For treatment do not pull at the vines from trees as this can cause disruption to habitat of small animals. Cut each stem above the ground then scrape and paint with herbicide. Ground cover can be pulled by hand. All foliage should be mulched or rafted to prevent regrowth.
